It has been decided to increase number of examination for Mates Phase-I and Phase-II so that candidates may writes examination more frequently.

Accordingly the written examination schedule is now revised and the number of occasions candidates may appear in the said examinations has now enhanced from existing four to seven times for Mates Phase-I and from four to six times a year for Mates Phase-II.
