Subject: Liaison Branches for Technical Services at the Directorate General of Shipping, Mumbai- reg.

The Directorate General of Shipping [DGS], Ministry of Shipping [MOS], Govt. of India [GOI] is the designated maritime administration for the shipping industry & its allied sectors in India. As a service oriented organization, intended for public interest, it provides multiple services, including, inter-alia, registration, survey, inspection, certification, approval, license & sanction. Various stakeholders in these sectors are the recipients of the operational services of the DGS, GOI. The Directorate discharges its mandated functions, under the provisions of various statutes, inter-alia, the Merchant Shipping [M.S.] Act, 1958, as amended and the Rules framed there-under and in accordance with the various international maritime Conventions and Codes.

In the contemporaneous era of a globalised & competitive business & technofinancial environment for the shipping industry, there is a critical & imperative need for the DGS to reorient itself to render such public services better, faster and with utmost transparency, more than even before, to stay relevant, responsible & responsive to the rising aspirations of the industry.

In this context, the need to re-engineer the business processes & procedures of the Directorate General of Shipping, GOI and its allied field offices, ie. the Mercantile Marine Departments [MMDs], etc., cannot be over-emphasized.

Towards this end, the various office systems as related to the dealing of matters pertaining to the three technical (i.e. Nautical (NT), Engineering (ENG) and Naval Architecture (NA) branches have since been reviewed, in their desired perspectives. In this light, three Appendices (vide infra) are attached to this Order, indicating the work-specialty-areas of the three respective branches ought to deal with. Appendix-I in particular shows the Liaison Branches whereby, based on the area of service as detailed in Annexure II, the customer/company has been guided to approach a particular branch for making the application and the branch from which the case would be disposed off.

The list of services provided is not exhaustive, but only indicative and all the recipients of the services from the Directorate and its allied offices are urged to suggest process corrections for further streamlining of the "service- delivery-system" of the Directorate.
