Subject: Resumption of e-pass facility – appointment of Nodal officer-reg.

Whereas, in view of the nationwide resurgence of COVID-19 cases and re-imposition of local and state-wide lock downs and travel restrictions by several state governments to contain the spread of virus, the Directorate General has vide DGS Order No. 15 of 2021 dated 28.04.2021 reinstated the system for issuance of e-pass as detailed vide DGS Order No. 12 of 2020 dated 22.04.2020, DGS Order No. 14 of 2020 dated 07.06.2020, DGS Order No. 21 of 2020 dated 20.07.2020 to facilitate inter-state and intra-state movement of seafarers who have been declared as 'Key Workers' vide DGS Crew Circular No. 37 of 2020 dated 22.12.2020.
