Amendment to DGS Order No. 39 of 2020 dated 21.11.2020

Subject: Standard Operating Procedures / Protocols (SOP) for sign-on of foreign seafarers in Indian ports - reg.

- The Directorate General of Shipping has issued instructions and SoP for sign-on of foreign 1. seafarers at Indian ports vide DGS Order No.39 of 2020 (F.No.23-71011/1/2020-CREW-DGS) dated 21.11.2020.
- Whereas, due to continuing restrictions on crew change at different ports around the world it 2. has been decided to facilitate Sign-On and Sign-Off of foreign crew at Indian ports. Para 6 of the DGS Order No.39 of 2020 is hereby amended to read as follows:-
 - "6 Along with the sign-off of foreign crew, sign-on of foreign crew shall also be facilitated at Indian ports subject to -
 - (a) sign-on / sign-off of foreign crew at outer anchorage shall be allowed without any restriction only after obtaining prior clearance from FRRO concerned.
 - (b) This will be only a temporary measure during the period when specific protocols are in place due to COVID 19 pandemic. Once COVID 19 pandemic protocols are removed, signon/sign-off procedure at outer anchorage should revert to the provisions as prescribed in sub-para (iii) of para 23.2 of the Visa Manual 2019."
- This issues with the concurrence of Ministry of Home Affairs vide their letter No. 3. 25022/17/2017-Imm(Part) dated 14.01.2021.
