I am directed to convey approval of the competent authority for reimbursement of course fee and examination fee for undertaking professional courses by the officers of DGS and its allied offices. The courses for which the reimbursement is allowed, are as follows:

i) Diploma in Shipping Management conducted by Narottam Morarjee Institute of Management (Two Years Course)- Rs. 18,000@ Rs. 9,000 per year

ii) MBA Programme (Shipping & Logistics Management) conducted by Tamil Nadu Open University Rs. 60,000@ Rs. 30,000 per year

- MBA Programme (Shipping & Logistics Management) conducted by Academy of Maritime Education & Training Rs. 60,000@ Rs. 30,000 per year
- iv) MBA Programme (Port & Shipping Management) conducted by Indian Maritime University Rs. 60,000@ Rs. 30,000 per year

2. The reimbursement of the course fee/examination fee is subject to the following conditions:

- The reimbursement of fees will be on a one time basis irrespective of the number of times an official requires to appear for the professional examination. The reimbursement would be made only after the employee qualifies /passes the examination and produces relevant certificate of passing to Head of the Office.
- Reimbursement would be admissible only for acquiring the above professional qualifications after induction into the service.
