OFFICE ORDER NO. 125 of 2024

Subject: Delegation of ISPS-Related Work

The Central Government notified the Merchant Shipping (Ships and Port Facility Security) Rules, 2024 on 19th June 2024 in accordance with Part-IXB of the Merchant Shipping Act, 1958, as amended. Further, the Central Government notified that the Director General of Shipping, appointed under Section 7 of said Act, shall be the designated authority for the purposes of Part-IXB of the Act on 20th June 2024.

2. The Director General of Shipping in accordance with Section 7(3) of the MS Act, hereby orders that the powers and responsibilities of Designated Authority stipulated in MS (ISPS) Rules, shall also be exercised by the Nautical Advisor for meeting the objectives of enhancing maritime security and ensuring implementation and compliance with the ISPS Rules, 2024. The Nautical Adviser may further delegate ISPS related work to the Nautical wing of the Directorate and respective MMDs as deemed fit.
