DGS Circular No. 24 of 2022

Sub: Addendum-I to the DGS Circular No. 4 of 2022 dated 15.02.2022 Constitution of the Port Facility Security Advisory Committee (PFSAC) of the
Major and Non-Major Ports-reg.

Whereas the Directorate had issued the DGS NT wing Circular 4 of 2022 dated 15.02.2022 regarding Constitution of the Port Facility Security Advisory Committee (PFSAC) of the Major and Non-Major Ports.

- 2. Whereas as per the Para No. 2 of the DGS NT wing Circular 4 of 2022 dated 15.02.2022, the PFSAC shall consist of one suitable representative from each of the following:-
 - Port Facility Security Officer (PFSO) of the respective ports.
 - Customs Department
 - Narcotics Control Bureau (NCB)
 - Central Intelligence Agencies (IB)
 - State Intelligence Agencies
 - Central Industrial Security Forces (CISF)
 - Local Police
 - Immigration Department
 - Indian Navy
 - Indian Coast Guard
 - Any other concerned agency of the Government [Central/State], as deemed fit by the Chairman/CEO of the concerned port.
- 3. In view of the directive from the National Security Council Secretariat (NSCS), the Directorate has reviewed the DGS NT wing Circular 4 of 2022 dated 15.02.2022, and has decided to include State Maritime Security Coordinators (SMSCs) as members of PFSACs.

4. This is issued with approval of the Director General of Shipping and Additional Secretary to the Government of India.
