CIRCULAR

It has been observed that officers/staff of the Directorate are bringing political influence for transfer/posting near to their home town, which is violation of CCS (Conduct) Rules, 1964. The Competent Authority has viewed it seriously and it is reiterated that such behavior is not appreciated and warrants prompt and stringent action as per rules.

- 2. In view of this, attention of all officers/staff is invited to the various provisions of the relevant rules, as indicated in the CCS (Conduct) Rules, 1964 says that "No Government servant shall bring or attempt to bring any political or other outside influence to bear upon any superior authority to further his interests in respect of matters pertaining to his service under the Government" for strict compliance.
- 3. Accordingly, the Competent Authority has directed to strictly comply with the aforesaid conduct rule failing which disciplinary action will be taken as per rules.
- 4. This issues with the approval of the Competent Authority.
