<u>Sub: Nomination of Rule-wise Nodal Officers for drafting of the Merchant Shipping Rules under Merchant Shipping Act, 2025 & Guiding Principles for drafting of Rules.</u>

I. Rule-wise Nodal officers:

As was discussed and directed in the meeting with all Nodal officers (nominated vide Directorate's order of even number dated 24.09.25), chaired by the Director General of Shipping, Gol., on 09.10.25, the list of rules and officers nominated for drafting of rules under the Merchant Shipping Act, 2025 shall be as enclosed as **Annexure-I,** for compliance.

II. <u>Timelines:</u>

<u>10 Step timelines</u> (already communicated to MoPSW, GoI) is enclosed as Annexure-II. No deviation in timelines is to be allowed for any Nodal officer.

III. Guiding Principles and Important Points for drafting of Rules:

(Notification dated 19.08.25 from Cabinet Secretariat is enclosed for guidance)

- (1) Ease of Doing Business and Ease of living in shipping sector to be taken care while prescribing inspections and in overall structure of rules.
- (2) Rules to be simpler, accommodative and liberal.
- (3) Reduce overall compliance burden for citizens and enterprises.
- (4) Consideration to be given areas which can be de-regulated.
- (5) Consideration to be given to reliance on self-certification and third-party inspection with scope of random inspection for monitoring purpose instead of conducting unnecessary or routine inspections.
- (6) Unnecessary process or procedure to be removed.
- (7) Process, Procedure, Forms and standards to be simpler and not cumbersome.
- (8) Best practices followed (India or outside) be incorporated in rules.

- (9) Decriminalize the regulatory and compliance requirements as much as possible
- (10) Proper consultation with stakeholders to be done. Record of stakeholder consultation during meeting or comments received on website, mail etc be maintained in Format give as Annexure-III.
- (11) Inputs received and responses made during stakeholders consultation at the stage of drafting of Act (when it was a Bill) to also be taken into consideration. DDG-MSL to circulate these documents to Nodal officers of rules.
- (12) Sections of existing MS Act, 1958/ existing Rules may be seen for procedural provisions to be taken to Rules but ensuring rationale.
- (13) Technical Committees order dated 24.09.25 read with Addendum dated 07.10.25 to be followed.
- (14) Advice of Law Ministry: Rules based on International Conventions/Protocol which are technical in nature may be drafted as Scheduled annexed to the Covering Rules. Advice of Legislative Department, Ministry of Law & Justice, Gol., for following Schedule method is enclosed as Annexure-IV. [Existing MS (Seafarers Accommodation) Rules, 2016 were drafted and notified in this way]. There may be more than one Schedule in a Rule based on Technicality in the Convention.

IV. Other salient points for smooth drafting and consultation process:

- (1) All legal material provided by Legal team (PLR Chambers) shall be taken into consideration while preparing the first draft of the rules.
- (2) DDG-MSL will circulate Tabular documents relating to the consultations held for the drafting of MS Act, 2025 (when it was draft Bill), for reference and incorporation of comments in rules as far as possible based on answer given during stakeholder process while framing the Act.
- (3) Responses where it was indicated that the specific comments will be addressed during rule-making, need to be taken into consideration by the nodal officers while preparing the draft rules.
- (4) Nodal officers to ensure that all first draft of rules sent for legal vetting clearly specify/indicate within the draft:
 - Any rule portion which has been taken from any of the following:
 - a) Any provision of the Merchant Shipping Act, 1958; or
 - b) Any existing rules under the Merchant Shipping Act, 1958; or
 - c) Any existing DGS circular/order/notice; or
 - d) Any aspect of any international convention; or
 - Any changes/modifications made to the above may be visible in track/colour coded.
 - Any rules which are newly drafted should also be indicated

- (5) The draft rules, as per the timelines, may be shared with the Legal Team of the DGS (PLR Chambers) at <u>sunidhi.sawhney@plrchambers.com</u> with copy to DDG-MSL (<u>amohd-dgs@nic.in</u>) and MSL Branch (<u>msl-dgs@nic.in</u>).
- (6) The following methodology needs to be followed by all nodal officers for stakeholder consultation meetings:
 - a. The dates for first stakeholder consultations for all technical committees will be specified in consultation with DDG, MSL in due course. An endeavour shall be made so that no more than one committee meeting (Constituted vide order dated 24.09.25) takes place in a day.
 - b. During meeting of Committees or stakeholder consultation meetings of every committee, all Nodal officers for each specific rule related to that committee, and attached resources shall be present for the meeting which will be held in DGS premises, with VC available for stakeholders to join.
 - c. For committee/stakeholder meetings, the nodal officers shall through its resources/office to ensure that:
 - the VC link for the meeting is circulated once the schedule of meeting is shared by DDG-MSL.
 - Every meeting is recorded and transcribed, and the recording and transcript is shared immediately after the meeting with DDG-MSL, nodal officers himself and DGS legal team (PLR Chambers);
 - All oral inputs provided by stakeholders in the meeting on the draft rules should be strictly captured in the format provided in Annexure-III. These inputs need to be captured live during the stakeholder meeting.
 - All written inputs provided by stakeholders on the draft rules should be strictly captured in the format provided in Annexure-III.
 - A master document of all stakeholder inputs received (oral and written) in the format of Annexure-III, should be maintained for every specific rule separately.
 - Detailed minutes of every meeting need to be made and shared with DDG-MSL, Nodal officers and DGS legal team (PLR Chambers) within the same day of the meeting.
 - Nodal officers shall take immediate decisions on stakeholder inputs during the stakeholder consultations or immediately after the meeting (without stakeholders) on the same day, and capture the decision taken along with the rationale in the format provided in Annexure-III. If needed guidance will be taken by the Nodal officer from HoDs/CS/NA/CSS.
 - All major re-drafting to be done based on comments accepted/partially accepted should be done at the time of taking the decision on each comment. Pending minor re-drafting (like consequent amendments, cross referencing etc) should be done within 1 working day after the



meeting (all changes made to the first draft pursuant to the stakeholder comments should be visible in track change mode).

The Ministry of Ports, Shipping and Waterways (the administrative Ministry) has sent an e-mail dated 22.09.2025 annexing therewith a copy of their Office Memorandum No.SR-22014/23/2025-MG (376629), dated 22.09.2025 seeking guidance from Legislative Department regarding drafting of rules under the Merchant Shipping Act, 2025.

- 2. The administrative Ministry has annexed a copy of an email, dated 17.09.2025 sent by the Directorate General of Shipping, Mumbai to them regarding clarification on drafting of rules/subordinate legislations based on International Conventions under the newly enacted Merchant Shipping Act, 2025, in which the said Directorate has stated that it is in the process of commencing the process of farming of subordinate legislation under the Merchant Shipping Act, 2025.
- 3. In this regard, the Directorate General of Shipping has stated that the Merchant Shipping Act, 2025 contains several provisions on the basis of several International Conventions and since it has initiated the process of framing subordinate legislation, sought guidance of the Legislative Department as to whether such rules may be drafted in either of the following ways:
 - (a) Reproduce or transpose in detail the substantive standards set out in the relevant International Conventions with only limited modifications for administrative purposes and alignment with the Act. This would create rules that are fully self-contained and accessible to stakeholders, but would also make the rules lengthy and necessitate frequent amendments each time the convention is revised;
 - (b) Cross-refer directly to the relevant convention provisions under each subject matter identified in the Act, limiting the rules to provisions on scope, applicability, administrative matters, and areas where the convention permits variance or flexibility for State Parties. This would ensure concise rules and facilitate automatic alignment with evolving international standards, but would require stakeholders to read the rules alongside the Convention text; or

- (c) draft rules in a so as to provide the relevant provisions of the Conventions (for example, specific annexes or regulations) as a Schedule annexed to the rules, while restricting the main operative part of rules to provide for the scope, applicability, administration, and permitted flexibilities. This would provide a consolidated domestic instrument without reproducing the convention in the body of the rules, but may still raise complexity in updating annexures. For instance, the Merchant Shipping (Seafarers Accommodation) Rules, 2016 was notified on 26.08.2016 in this manner. This appears to be more convenient way for reference of stakeholders and ease of business.
- In this context, it is to state that, as it is observed by the said Directorate, by reproducing or transposing in detail the substantive standards set out in the relevant International Conventions will make the rules lengthy and necessitate frequent amendments each time the convention is revised. As regard the second option of cross-reference to the relevant Convention provisions under each subject matter identified in the Act, Hon'ble Parliamentary Committee on Subordinate Legislation has time and again made recommendations to avoid referential legislation as much as possible. Among the three options, the third option is the appropriate way of drafting subordination legislation, in this behalf, so as to provide the relevant provisions of the Conventions as Schedule annexed to the rules while restricting the main operative part of rules to provide for the scope, applicability, administration, and permitted flexibilities.
- Further, the said Directorate has requested the administrative Ministry to request the Legislative Department to assign the vetting of rules to same officer (as far as feasible), who has drafted and vetted the Merchant Shipping Act, 2025 a meeting may also be arranged with the officer of the Legislative Department to discuss and seek guidance on the drafting method to be adopted for rules. In this regard, it is to inform that subordinate legislation proposals are examined in accordance with the work distribution order issued in this Department, from time to time. As per the current work allocation relating to Subordinate legislation in the Department, the Ministry of Ports, Shipping and Waterways is being dealt in this Group. Therefore, the officers of the administrative Ministry and Directorate of Shipping may come for discussion on any issue relating to the drafting of the rules, if needed, on any working day with prior intimation.
- 6. Accordingly, we may inform the administrative Ministry for necessary action.
