DGS Circular No. 44 of 2025

Subject: Strengthening Compliance and Operational Use of Visitor Access Management System (VAMS) in the DGS Premises reg.

Reference is invited to DGS Order No. 07 of 2025 dated 10.06.2025, issued by the E-Governance Branch, regarding the implementation and institutionalization of the Visitor Access Management System (VAMS) across all branches/wings of the Directorate General of Shipping (DGS).

- 3. However, a recent review conducted jointly by the Administration Branch (custodian of VAMS) and the IT & E-Governance Branch has revealed the following critical lapses:

4. Observations

a) Non-utilization of Assigned Credentials :

Despite issuance of login credentials to officers listed in Annexure-I, several officers have not accessed the VAMS App or initiated any scheduling activity. Specific instances are noted in the "Remarks" column of Annexure-I.

b) Unauthorized Entry via Alternate Routes:

Reports indicated that certain visitors are entering through non-designated access points such as the service lift and the fire-exit adjacent entry, bypassing the main entrance where VAMS verification is mandated. These entries remain unrecorded, posing security and administrative risks.

c) Bypassing Appointment Verification

Instances have been noted where officers are entertaining visitors without verifying their appointments on the VAMS platform, thereby undermining the system's integrity and accountability framework.

d) Incomplete Meeting Closure Logs

Officers have failed to mark the conclusion of meetings on the VAMS App, resulting in inaccurate duration records and compromised analytics.

5. Directives for Immediate Compliance.

To ensure robust visitor management and uphold institutional discipline, the following directives are issued for strict and immediate adherence:

(i.) Mandatory Use of VAMS

All officers listed in Annexure-I shall exclusively use the VAMS App for scheduling, approving and concluding visitor meetings. No visitor shall be permitted entry without a valid, preapproved appointment in the system. Exceptions (subject to manual recording and approval) include:

- · Senior Government Officials
- · Accredited Foreign Delegations
- Individuals/groups/delegations expressly permitted by the Director General of Shipping

(ii.) Deadline for App Installation

All designated officers must download, install, and activate the VAMS App on their official/personal smartphones by 09.10.2025 positively.

(iii.) Restriction on Entry Points

Effective immediately, all alternate entry points (including service lift and fire-exit adjacent entry) shall be sealed for visitor access. Only the main entrance shall be used by all visitors and

all officials of the Directorate including the staff working on contract basis with mandatory VAMS verification by security personnel.

(iv.) Closure of Meeting Logs

Officers must ensure that all meetings initiated via VAMS are properly concluded in the system upon completion to maintain accurate records and enable effective reporting.

6. Monitoring and Oversight

The Administration Branch, in coordination with the Security and IT & E- Governance Branches, shall conduct continuous monitoring to ensure compliance.

- 7. All officers and staff are directed to extend full cooperation and uphold the objectives of the Digital Visitor Management System in both letter and spirit.
