<u>Subject: Welfare Schemes Administered by Seafarers' Welfare Fund Society (SWFS) for Indian Seafarers - reg.</u>

The Directorate General of Shipping (DGS), an attached office under the Ministry of Ports, Shipping and Waterways (MoPSW), Government of India, serves as the apex maritime authority responsible for the development, regulation, and promotion of the Indian shipping industry. Since its establishment in 1949, the DGS has played a pivotal role in formulating and implementing shipping policies, maritime safety regulations, and standards for maritime education and training.

- 2. The Seafarers' Welfare Fund Society (SWFS), a central organization registered under the Societies Registration Act, 1860, and the Bombay Public Trust Act, 1950, operates under the administrative purview of the Directorate General of Shipping. As provided under Section 101 of the Merchant Shipping Act, 1958, the SWFS manages the Seafarers' Welfare Fund, which is dedicated to providing a wide array of welfare services and support mechanisms for Indian seafarers and their families, both in India and abroad.
- 3. The SWFS is governed by a Committee of Management (CoM) comprising representatives from Indian and foreign shipowners, seafarers' unions, and government nominees, and is chaired by the Director General of Shipping. The Society is responsible for funding welfare infrastructure, providing grants, acquiring assets, and implementing various physical and digital welfare enhancement projects.
- 4. In accordance with the objectives outlined in Article 3 (XV) of the Society's Memorandum of Association, financial assistance may be granted to Indian seafarers who meet the eligibility criteria specified in Rule 3 of the Society's regulations. Assistance to seafarers and their families are provided under the following schemes:
 - Survivor Benefit Scheme (SBS) Financial assistance to the family of a deceased Indian seafarer



- 2. **Invalidity Benefit Scheme (IBS)** Support for Indian seafarers declared permanently unfit for sea service
- 3. **Family Benefit Welfare Scheme (FBWS)** Effective from January 1, 2019, this scheme provides support to dependent families of seafarers
- 4. **Maternity Benefit Scheme (MBS)** Financial assistance for Indian women seafarers during maternity
- 5. Old Age Benefit Welfare Scheme (OABS) Assistance for seafarers who attain the age of 65 years on or after January 1, 2019
- 6. **Death on Board Benefit Scheme (DBBS)** Support in cases of death or presumed death occurring on board
- 7. Ex-Gratia Support Benefit Scheme (ESBS) Additional financial aid for specific cases of hardship
- Award to Meritorious Child of Seafarers (AMCS) Educational incentives for children of Indian seafarers
- 5. All Recruitment and Placement Services (RPS) agencies, shipping companies, seafarers' unions, welfare associations, Maritime Training Institutes (MTIs) and other relevant stakeholders are hereby advised to:
- Disseminate the information provided in this circular to both active and retired Indian seafarers
- Assist eligible beneficiaries in accessing application forms and related scheme documentation
- Encourage seafarers' families to keep their contact and banking details updated with the Seafarers Welfare Fund Society (SWFS)

SURVIVOR BENEFIT SCHEME

DETAILS OF THE 'SURVIVOR BENEFIT SCHEME' FOR THE NOMINEES OF THE DECEASED INDIAN SEAFARER, WHO DIED DURING OFF ARTICLE PERIOD.

- 1. Pursuant to the objects of the Seafarers' Welfare Fund Society (herein after referred to as the Society) as defined in Article 3(XV) of the Memorandum of Association of the Society, the nominee(s) of the Indian seafarer, as being eligible in terms of provisions of rule 3 herein below, may be granted the financial assistance under the 'Survivor Benefit Scheme', on death of the *Indian* seafarer under the circumstances and to the extent detailed herein below.
- 2. Such financial assistance on death of an *Indian* seafarer shall be granted at the absolute discretion of the society and such financial assistance may be dispensed with and / or curtailed /enhanced, suspended or completely withdrawn at any time without any prior notice. The availability of such *financial assistance under the 'Survivor Benefit Scheme'* to eligible *beneficiary(ies)* of deceased Indian seafarer, during off articled period does not in any manner confer or create any prescriptive right whatsoever and shall not be called in question.

3. Eligibility.

The scheme is applicable to the *Indian* seafarers, *holding CDC book*, who are *last* recruited / engaged by the Indian ship-owners or through registered RPS, for either Indian or foreign flag vessels, before their death.

The financial assistance under the 'Survivor Benefit Scheme' on death of an *Indian* seafarer shall be paid to the eligible beneficiary (ies), of the *Indian* seafarer who has expired on or after 21.08.2014, within off article period of 12 months (amended to 24 months w.e.f. 31/05/2022) from the date of sign off from the last vessel/ship as recruited/engaged above. The eligible beneficiary (ies), will be as per the nomination(s) declared by the Indian seafarer with the last recruited Indian ship-owner or registered RPS company, as the case maybe during his/her employment, prior to his/her death., failing which as per legal heir certificate issued by the competent authority.

4. Quantum.

The quantum of financial assistance under this scheme shall be \ge 1, 00,000/- (\ge 0ne lakh only) to the eligible beneficiary (ies) of the *Indian* seafarer. (**Refer note given below**)

- 5. The Society may approach the Indian ship-owners /registered RPS, company concerned and obtain such particulars as may be necessary for the purpose of payment of financial assistance envisaged under this scheme.
- 6. To receive the benefit under this scheme only such applications will be entertained *which* are submitted to Seafarers' Welfare Fund Society within a period of two years upto 30/05/2022 and three years for death of seafarer which occurred on or after 31/05/2022 from the date of death of the *Indian* seafarer.
- 7. Application for financial assistance under this scheme is to be made in the prescribed form, along with attested copy of death certificate and original CDC book.



8. Notwithstanding anything contained herein above in all doubtful/disputed and/or exceptional cases, the Committee of Management *of the SWFS* may examine and decide the cases, on case to case basis, and its decision shall be final.

Note 1: The amount of financial assistance has been enhanced to ₹. 2,00,000/- (Rupees Two lacs only) w.e.f. 16/03/2016 for those death cases of seafarer who has expired on or after 16.03.2016 within off article period of 12 months from the date of sign off from the last vessel/ship as recruited/engaged by Indian Shipping company or through RPSL company.

Note 2: The amount of financial assistance has been enhanced to ₹. 4,00,000/- (Rupees Four Lackhs only) w.e.f. 29/04/2024 for those death cases of seafarer who has expired on or after 29/04/2024, within off article period of 24 months from the date of sign off from the last vessel/ship as recruited/engaged by Indian Shipping company or through RPSL company.

INVALIDITY BENEFIT SCHEME

DETAILS OF THE 'INVALIDITY BENEFIT SCHEME' FOR THE INDIAN SEAFARER WHO BECOME PERMANANTLY UNFIT FOR SEAFARING PROFESSION DURING OFF ARTICLE PERIOD.

- 1. Pursuant to the objects of the Seafarers' Welfare Fund Society (herein after referred to as the Society) as defined in Article 3(XV) of the Memorandum of Association of the Society, the *Indian* seafarer, as being eligible in terms of provisions of rule 3 herein below, may be granted the financial assistance under the 'Invalidity Benefit Scheme', on becoming permanently unfit for seafaring profession under the circumstances and to the extent detailed herein below.
- 2. Such financial assistance to for the Indian seafarer, on becoming permanently unfit for seafaring profession shall be paid, at the absolute discretion of the society and such financial assistance, may be dispensed with and / or curtailed /enhanced, suspended or completely withdrawn at any time without any prior notice. The availability of such *financial assistance under the* 'Invalidity Benefit Scheme' to the eligible *Indian* seafarer, during off article period does not in any manner confer or create any prescriptive right whatsoever and shall not be called in question.

3. Eligibility.

The scheme, is applicable to the *Indian* seafarers, *holding CDC book*, and who are *last* recruited / engaged, by Indian ship-owners or through registered RPS, for either Indian or foreign flag vessels, before occurrence of an injury, due to which he/she became permanently unfit for seafaring profession.

The *financial assistance under the* 'Invalidity Benefit Scheme' shall be granted to the *Indian* seafarer, who has become permanently unfit, for the seafaring profession, due to an injury that occurred on or after 21.08.2014, during off article period of 12 months (amended to 24 month w.e.f. 31/05/2022), from the date of sign off from the last vessel/ship, as recruited/engaged above.

4. Quantum.

The quantum of financial assistance under this scheme shall be ₹.1,00,000/- (₹One lakh only) to the eligible *Indian* seafarer. (**Refer Note given below**.)

- 5. The Society may approach the Indian ship-owners /registered RPS, company concerned and obtain such particulars as may be necessary for the purpose of payment of financial assistance envisaged under this scheme.
- 6. To receive the benefit under this scheme only such applications will be entertained **which** are submitted to Seafarers' Welfare Fund Society within a period of **two** years upto 30/05/2022 and for accidental injury which occurred on or after 31/05/2022 the time limit is increased to three years from the date of certificate issued by the DGS approved medical practitioner.
- 7. Application for financial assistance under this scheme is to be made in the prescribed form, along with the certificate issued by the DGS approved Medical Practitioner certifying the *Indian* seafarer 'Permanently Unfit' for the seafaring profession due to injury, copy of discharge card/certificate and medical report card issued by the hospital (where the said Indian seafarer was admitted for the treatment) and original CDC Book.
- 8. Notwithstanding anything contained herein above in all doubtful/disputed and/or exceptional cases, the Committee of Management of the SWF Society may examine and decide, on case to case basis, and its decision shall be final.

Note 1: The amount of financial assistance has been enhanced to Rs. 200000/- (Rupees Two lacs only) w.e.f. 16/03/2016 for the seafarer, where the injury to the seafarer has occurred on or after 16.03.2016, within off article period of 12 months from the date of sign off from the last vessel/ship.

Note 1: The amount of financial assistance has been enhanced to Rs. 6,00,000/- (Rupees Six lacs only) w.e.f. 29/04/2024 for the seafarer, where the injury to the seafarer has occurred on or after 29/04/2024, within off article period of 24 months from the date of sign off from the last vessel/ship.

DETAILS OF THE "FAMILY BENEFIT WELFARE SCHEME" FOR THE INDIAN SEAFARERS WITH EFFECT FROM 01.01.2019.

- 1. Pursuant to the objects of the Seafarers' Welfare Fund Society (hereinafter referred to as the Society) as defined in Article 3(XV) of the Memorandum of Association of the Society, the Indian seafarer as being eligible in terms of provisions of the rule 3 herein below, may be provided the financial assistance under "FAMILY BENEFIT WELFARE SCHEME" from 1st January 2019 under the circumstances and to the extent detailed herein below.
- 2. Such financial assistance to the Indian seafarer shall be provided, for the successful completion of Presea training course or Post-graduation degree/diploma as given below, by their son/daughter. At the absolute discretion of the society such financial assistance, may be dispensed with and / or curtailed or enhanced, suspended or completely withdrawn at any time without any prior notice. The availability of such financial assistance under the "Family Benefit welfare scheme" to the eligible Indian seafarer does not in any manner confer or create any prescriptive right whatsoever and shall not be called in question.
- 3. Such financial assistance shall be provided to the Indian seafarer-
- (a) Whose son/daughter successfully completes the Pre-sea training course (GP rating/ CCMC/Deck & Engine Cadet including ETO), on or after 1.1.2019, from the Institute approved by the Directorate General of Shipping, Govt. of India and obtains the Indian CDC for joining seafaring profession.
- (b) Whose son/daughter successfully completes two years full-time post-graduation degree/diploma in any discipline other than Maritime stream, on or after 1.1.2019, from duly approved University by UGC/Deemed University/AlCTE approved institute.
- Eligibility: The scheme is applicable to the Indian seafarer, who fulfils all the following conditions and
 is restricted to two children only.
- (i) He / She should have cumulative 6 months sea service after 01 .04.2014, preceding five years from the date of submission of claim application.
- (ii) He / She should have joined Indian flag vessel or engaged through registered RPS License holding company on Indian or Foreign flag vessel; and
- (iii) He / She should have an Indian CDC.

5. Quantum:

The quantum of financial assistance under this scheme shall be as under.

- (a) Where Indian Seafarer's son/daughter completes the Pre-sea training course & obtains the Indian CDC, the financial assistance under this scheme shall be Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty five Thousand Only) in respect of son & Rs.50,000/- (Rupees Fifty Thousand Only) in respect of daughter and it will be provided to the seafarer.
- (b) Where Indian Seafarer's son/daughter completes the two years full time post-graduation degree/diploma course in any discipline other than Maritime stream, the financial assistance under this scheme shall be Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only) in respect of son & Rs.15,000/- (Rupees Fifteen Thousand Only) in respect of daughter and it will be provided to the seafarer.
- 6. The Society may approach the Indian ship-owners/registered RPS Company concerned to obtain such particulars as may be necessary, for the purpose of payment of financial assistance envisaged under this scheme.
- 7. To receive the benefit under this scheme only such applications will be entertained which are submitted to the Seafarers' Welfare Fund Society within a period of twelve months after completion of course.
- 8. Application for financial assistance under this scheme is to be made in the prescribed form along with self attested copy of latest CDC book & copies of certificates.

Or

9. Notwithstanding anything contained herein above in all doubtful/disputed and/or exceptional cases, the Committee of Management of the SWFS may examine and decide the cases, on case to case basis and its decision shall be final.

Note 1: The Committee of Management (COM) in its meeting dated 12/03/2025 has decided to provide the same amount, at par to the Children of seafarers. i.e. (i) Rs. 50,000/- for completion of pre-sea training course & (ii) Rs. 25,000/- for passing post-graduate two years full time degree / diploma from the University approved by the UGC / Deemed University / AICTE approved institute w.e.f. 01/04/2025. The other terms & conditions of this 'Family Benefit Schemes' remains same.

Such financial assistance on being stranded / abandoned of an Indian seafarer shall be granted at the absolute discretion of the society and such financial assistance may be dispensed with and / or curtailed /enhanced, suspended or completely withdrawn at any time without any prior notice. The availability of such financial assistance under the 'Ex-Gratia Support Benefit Scheme' to the eligible beneficiary of the stranded/abandoned seafarer does not in any manner confer or create any prescriptive right whatsoever and shall not be called in question.

2. Eligibility.

The financial assistance under the 'Ex-Gratia Support Benefit Scheme' will be paid to the seafarer's next of kin of Standard/abandoned, by their owners/ employers/RPSL till their standard period or maximum of 12 months. "FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE BY WAY OF AWARD TO CHILDREN OF SEAFARERS"

1. Objective:

Pursuant to the objects of the Seafarers' Welfare Fund Society (herein after referred to as the Society) as defined in Article 3(XV) of the Memorandum of Association of the Society, the child of the Indian seafarer, as being eligible in terms of provisions of rule 3 herein below, may be granted the 'Financial Assistance by Way of Award', to recognize and encourage academic excellence among the children of Indian under the circumstances and to the extent detailed herein below.

2. Scope of the Scheme:

The scheme shall cover children of seafarers who secure top position (First Rank) in the following academic categories:

- i. University Graduation Degree
- ii. Post-Graduate Degree examinations from UGC recognized Indian universities and Deemed Universities

3. Eligibility Criteria:

A. For the Seafarer:

- Must be an Indian seafarer holding Indian CDC.
- Must have completed a minimum of 1 year of service on board Indian or foreign-flag vessels.
- And must have sailed for minimum 6 months during past 5 years.

B. For the Child (Awardee):

- Must be the biological or legally adopted child of the eligible seafarer.
- · Must have appeared for and topped the relevant examination in the first attempt.
- Must produce a valid certificate issued by the examination authority confirming the top rank or highest marks.
- Must have completed the course from a recognized institution (as detailed under each category below).

4. Categories and Quantum of Award: ₹.25,000/-

- i. University Degree and Postgraduate Exams:
 - Award: Rs. 25,000/-
- · Eligibility:
 - Children topping full-time final year undergraduate or Final Year Post-graduate degree examinations.
 - o The course must be from an Indian University recognized by UGC or a Deemed University.
 - o Mark sheets, rank certificate, and Bonafide certificates to be submitted as proof.

5. Number of Awards:

- Only one award per category / per academic year.
- In case of a tie (equal highest scores), the award may be shared or decided through additional meritbased criteria set by the Committee.

6. Application Procedure:

- Applications must be submitted by the parent (seafarer) or the student with all required documents.
- Application window: Within 3 months of the declaration of the examination results.
- · Documents Required:
 - o Copy of seafarer's CDC with sea service details.
 - Marksheet and rank certificate of the child who topped the University, issued by the University / Deemed University.



- o Bonafide certificate from the institute / University.
- o Birth certificate of the Child for relationship proof.

7. Approval and Disbursement:

- Applications will be screened by the Welfare Sub-Committee.
- Recommendations will be forwarded to the Member Secretary/ Chairman-SWFS for final approval.
- Approved awards will be disbursed on the Seafarers Day / NMDC Celebration Ceremony

8. General Conditions:

- The decision of the Welfare Sub-Committee will be final in all matters relating to selection, eligibility, and disbursement.
- The Committee of Management of the SWFS reserves the right to amend, suspend, or cancel the scheme at any time.
