The Chief Examiner of Engineers has been receiving increasing number of representations from both the candidates and the shipping companies regarding the delay in the issuance of Certificate of Competency. To obviate above, all the districts were instructed to forward the results to DGS along with the DGS Final register by the 20<sup>th</sup> of the following month in which MEO exams are held, for the purpose of expediting the issuance of Certificate of Competency.

- 2. As per the new procedure, after completion of MEO examinations and forwarding of all documents by the examination centers to this Directorate, the results will be approved by the Chief Examiner and declared before the end of the following month. It is envisaged that COCs of successful candidates will be dispatched from Directorate within 10 days of declaration of Results.
- 3. In this procedure, unsuccessful candidates will not be able to sit for the examination in consecutive month.
- 4. In consideration of requests received from candidates, the Chief Examiner of Engineers has now modified the instructions and have now decided that candidates may be allowed to apply for the Oral examination only in the following month, irrespective of whether he has passed the written examination, prior to declaration of overall results by the Chief Examiner of Engineers.
