Sub: Class I MEO Engineering Management Course - Regarding

In accordance with the provisions of the rules as specified in Meta Manual Volume 1, Section M-III/3 (Ref: M.S.(STCW) Rule 23), the examination and assessment for Marine Engineering Officer Class I for those candidates who have commenced their training under the STCW 95 Rules [Merchant Shipping (Standards of Training Certification and Watchkeeping for Seafarers), Rules 1998] is specified in Para 6 of the said Section. One of the requirements of Para 6.2 is the satisfactory completion of the approved Engineering Management Course. The Directorate after due consideration has now compiled the course curriculum for a period of 2 months to be conducted at the 3 institutes viz. Marine Engineering Research Institute, Kolkata, Marine Engineering Research Institute, Mumbai and National Institute of Port Management, Chennai. Subsequent to the satisfactory completion of the course, the candidate would be required to pass an Engineering Management Paper of 3 hours at MMD, followed by an oral examination as is laid down in Para 6.4.1 of Section M-III/3 of Meta Manual Volume 1. The written examination would be of 3 hours and shall be conducted by the MMD where the candidates have been assessed and found eligible for the said examination. The oral examination shall also be conducted at the same MMD, subsequent to successful passing of the written examination. All assessment of eligibility shall be done at the 3 MMDs viz. Mumbai, Kolkata and Chennai. The curriculum for the Management Training Course is also put up on the DG Shipping website for information. The first Engineering Management Examination shall be held in January 2004 and regularly thereafter.

This circular must be given wide publicity for the benefit of aspiring candidates.
