Subject: Intimation regarding booking for 2M FG [OLY FRESH CANDIDATES],
1st mate Ph-I (FG), 1st mate Ph-II(FG) & ASM (FG) written examinations & Oral examinations
of all grades, September 2021.reg

1. Booking window will be opened from 1000 hrs on 19.08.2021 to 2300 hrs on 27.08.2021 for ONLY FRESH candidates of 2M FG, Fresh and repeater candidates of 1st mate Ph-I (FG), 1st Mate Ph-II (FG) and ASM (FG) **WRITTEN** examinations, tentatively scheduled to commence in 1st of September'2021. [Note: The examination schedule will be displayed on DGS website. The date may change depending on the circumstances. Candidates may, therefore, continue to monitor DGS website for any change in date of examination.
2. Repeater candidates of 2M FG may not book their seat as their fees would be forfeited. Repeater candidates of 2M FG will be intimated regarding seat booking through separate notice.
3. Oral examination of nautical discipline will be accepted for those candidates who have passed all parts of written examinations, signal examination as well as completed the relevant modular courses and eligible for the oral examination.
4. Candidates who are currently serving on a ship (Articles of a ship) are not eligible to apply for online oral examination.
5. Candidate has option for attending oral examination at MMD or remotely by online platform. Candidate is required to specify whether online or physical exam method is being selected. Candidates choosing remote online platform need to comply with the requirements of Annex-I of the notice dated 10.05.2021 regarding 'Instructions to candidate for attending oral examination of nautical discipline using online video-conferencing platform.
6. Candidates who are not eligible for appearing in oral examination and those who cannot comply with Annex-I requirement (if remote online option is chosen) as stated in para 5 of this notice using online platform may not book their seat as their fees would be forfeited.
7. Fresh applicants may complete the online assessment process at the respective MMDs as per usual practice. Candidates may forward the required documents for assessment of eligibility to the MMD through the institute by speed post or courier at the earliest. Candidate need not

visit MMD for the purpose of assessment. Once assessment is approved, fresh candidates can book seats for Examination.

8. The MMDs will display the dates of conduct of the signal visual examination. Candidates may therefore contact the respective MMD for details regarding the conduct of signal visual examinations.

9. This is issued with the approval of the Chief Examiner of Master and Mates and the Nautical Advisor to the Government of India (i/c).
