The items shall be sold to the bidder who will quote the highest rate per KG for the used/condemned steel compactors. The bids are invited for the whole lot and no bid would be accepted for any part of the same.

Desirous companies may download the tender document from GeM Portal and submit the bids online in the GEM Portal.

Bidders are required to quote the highest offered price per KG of the steel unit. Payment to be settled by the successful bidders based on actual weight of all the units which will be verified by the committee either in weighbridge or portable weighing scale.			

Eligibility Criteria for the bidders:

1. The bidder should deposit Rs. 30,000/- as EMD in the form of an Account Payee Demand Draft (DD) from a scheduled Bank in favour of Principal Officer, Mercantile Marine Department (in original) in the office of the Mercantile Marine Department, Ground Floor, Nau Bhavan, Ballard Estate, Fort, Mumbai - 400001 before the cut-off date of submission of online Bid through GeM. A soft copy of the same should be uploaded on GeM portal. The Bid without EMD (in original) will be liable for rejection. EMD of the unsuccessful bidder shall be returned without interest within 30 days of declaration of result of technical evaluation.

2. Copy of PAN No., GST No., Aadhar/Address Proof, in the name of the proprietor/owner/firm/company is required to be uploaded on the GeM Portal. The document to be uploaded should be legible. In case the uploaded documents are not readable, the bid cannot be examined, and the bid can be rejected, thereby rejecting the bid of that firm.

3. The company/agency/firm should have a registered office or one of the branch offices in Mumbai Metropolitan Region only. A documentary proof of the same should be uploaded with documents.

Terms and Conditions:

1. The items are available for Auction on "**As is where is basis**". The Used/Condemned compactors can be inspected by the interested parties on any working days by contacting the office of Mercantile Marine Department, Ground Floor, Nau Bhavan, Ballard Estate, Fort, Mumbai – 400001 (Phone No. 022-22076881). No request for inspection after submission of the bid will be accepted. The Competent Authority of the Mercantile Marine Department reserves all rights to accept/reject any/all bids including bids of those bidders who fail to comply with the instructions without assigning any reason, whatsoever and does not bind itself to accept the lowest/highest or any specific bids. The decision of the Competent Authority in this regard shall be final and binding.

2. The bid shall remain valid for 30 days after the date of bid opening. If any bidder withdraws his / her bid before the said period, the department shall without prejudice to any other right or remedy, be at liberty to forfeit the EMD absolutely.

3. Conditional bids shall not be entertained.

4. **The successful bidder will be the one which offer the highest rate per KG of steel units for the entire lot of used compactors as detailed in Scope of Work. Payment to be settled by the successful bidders based on actual total weight of all the units which will be verified by the committee either in weighbridge or using portable weighing scale.** No items, once sold to the successful bidder, shall be taken back by the Mercantile Marine Department in any condition, whatsoever. Further, No part lifting of the items shall be allowed.

5. All the bidders shall fill the details of EMD column on GeM Portal if the option is available before submission of bids.

6. MMD Mumbai will not entertain any claim for damage done by the way of theft, fire or any other unforeseen calamity after realizing full payment against the Used/condemned compactors.

7. EMD of the successful bidder will be adjusted in the final payment. On acceptance of the bid, balance amount of the total bid price should be deposited by the successful bidder within 5 working days after award of bid, failing which the offer may be cancelled and EMD/Bid Security may stand forfeited. Thereafter, the items is to be lifted up within 5 days on the issue of Release Order after making full payment. The payment shall be made in the form of an Account Payee Demand Draft (DD) in favour of Principal Officer, Mercantile Marine Department, Mumbai. Otherwise, the EMD money deposited will stand forfeited and the offer shall be awarded to the next eligible bidder.

8. The successful bidder must dismantle / lift all the items at his own cost.

9. Bidders are also required to submit a declaration in the format given below along with documents that they have inspected the items and interested to purchase the same on “**As Is, Where Is Basis**” and agree with the T&C given in the bid document.

10. **Financial bid:** The bidders will be required to submit their financial bid indicating the **highest price offered per KG of steel units** in the GeM portal. Taxes, levies if any applicable shall be borne by the bidders.
11. MMD Mumbai does not guarantee to make any definite quantity and quality of articles available to the buyer.
12. The lifting of items must be done during working office hours between 10 am to 05 pm.
13. The lifting of the items shall be done without damaging the premises / roads / drains/ etc. The buyer shall compensate the damages, loss, etc., in the event of any occurrence otherwise.
14. No selection or sorting whatsoever of the goods will be allowed at the premises. The entire lot should be cleared by getting proper Gate Pass from office of MMD Mumbai.
15. Any uncleared or un-noticed materials left over by the successful bidder within the premises cannot be claimed later.
16. No enquiry of bidder shall be entertained once the material is lifted by them.
17. GST, as applicable at the time of disposal shall be charged extra and will be borne by the successful bidder. The successful bidder shall deposit the GST amount in the relevant Government Account on behalf of MMD Mumbai as per Section 9(4) of CGST Act, 2017, and also furnish the receipt of the same. A copy of the GST payment challan should be furnished to the department at the time of submitting DD for final payment of auctioned goods.

18. The materials being disposed is to be treated in line with applicable rules/notifications/ guidelines etc. as may be prescribed by the Government. The successful bidder shall be responsible to ensure this action and any liability whatsoever shall be borne by the bidder solely.

19. At any time, MMD Mumbai reserves the right to modify the bidding document by amendment thereto. The amendment will be notified on website only, which will be binding on bidders. Bidders should regularly visit the website <https://dgshipping.gov.in> to keep themselves updated.

20. Bidders are also required to furnish an Affidavit to the effect that their firm/company/agency has not been blacklisted by Central/State Govt./PSU.

21. The employees of this department are not eligible to take part in the auction process.

22. The department reserves the right to accept or reject any or all the bids received without assigning any reason thereof.

23. All disputes including court proceeding shall be settled through negotiation within the time of bids. However, the legal claim shall be within the Mumbai Jurisdiction only.

24. No party shall be considered in breach of any T&C of this Contract to the extent that performance of their respective obligations (excluding payment obligations) is prevented by an Event of Force Majeure that arises after the tender publishing date.

25. Bidders not complying with the above conditions are liable to be rejected
