Subject: Intimation Regarding Booking for 2nd Mate (FG), ASM (FG), NWKO (NCV), and Fishing Grade Written Examinations, as well as All Grades of Oral Examinations for September 2024– reg.

The booking window will be open from 1000 hrs on 01.08.2024 to 1800 hrs on 25.08.2024 for fresher and repeater candidates of 2nd Mate (FG), ASM (FG), NWKO (NCV), and Fishing Grade for written examinations and all grades of oral examinations. Written exams are tentatively scheduled to commence from 02.09.2024 [Note: The examination schedule has been displayed on DGS website.] The date may change depending on the circumstances. Candidates, therefore, continue to monitor the DGS website for any change in the date examination.

- 2. The booking window may commence from 01.08.2024 to 25.08.2024 to facilitate the candidates (freshers and repeaters). However, candidates are advised to follow the instructions provided by their respective MMDs in this regard.
- 3. All NCV written examination will be conducted in Mumbai Only, & Fishing Grade written examination will be conducted in Chennai only.
- 4. Candidates are requested to be guided by DGS (NT/Exam) Circular No. 13 of 2022 dated 16.06.2022, and N.T. Wing/EAC Branch Nautical Circular No. 16 of 2024 dated 01.07.2024 for booking and appearing in competency examinations of the nautical discipline.
- 5. All the relevant modular courses need to be completed for the oral examination.
- 6. Candidates who are serving on a ship (Articles of a ship) are not eligible for applying for an online examination.

Candidates who are unable to appear in an online oral examination may opt to attend the oral examination at MMDs. In such cases, candidates are required to specify their preference by emailing the Exam Centre of the concerned MMD immediately upon booking, including the booking reference details, and indicating whether they are selecting the online

or physical examination method. Even in this situation, the oral examination at the MMD will

be conducted through an online platform at the MMD.

8. Candidates need to comply with the requirements of Annex I of the notice dated

10.05.2021 regarding "Instructions to the candidates for attending oral examination of

nautical discipline using the online video-conferencing platform.

9. Candidate who are not eligible for appearing in oral examination and those who cannot

comply with Annex-I requirements stated in para 8 of this notice, may not book their seat as

their fees would be forfeited.

10. Fresh applicants may complete the online assessment process at the respective MMDs

as per usual practice. Candidate may forward the required documents for assessment of

eligibility to the MMD through the institute by speed post or courier at the earliest. The

candidate need not visit MMD for the purpose of assessment. Once the assessment is

approved, fresh candidates can book seats for the Examination.

11. The MMDs will display the dates of conduct of the signal visual examination.

Candidates may therefore contact the respective MMD for details regarding the conduct of

signal visual examinations.
